If you ring the AA Helpline you will be advised to go to as many meetings as you can, to get a home group and to get a sponsor. When you are a FI/FO worker the number of meetings you can actually get to is very limited – in most cases you can only get to meetings when you are in the Metro area on your very limited time off.
